Less than 1% of Jersey heifers experience problems with their first calf, while nearly 8% of Holsteins had difficult calvings requiring assistance according to studies by AGIL scientists. As well, Jerseys return to their heat cycle sooner and breed back earlier with fewer services per conception.

Jerseys consume 12.94 lbs of feed to make one pound of cheddar cheese. Holsteins need 16.124 lbs of feed to make the same pound of cheddar cheese.
